### **What is California Proposition 65**

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 requires the governor of the state of California to republish at least once per year the list of chemicals known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. Businesses are required to provide Californians that may be exposed to these chemicals with a clear and reasonable warning about chemicals in the products they purchase, in their home or workplace, or that are released into the environment.

### **How the Warnings are provided**

MG Chemicals and its resellers provides Proposition 65 warnings through one or all of these means:

- Product labels
- Web pages
- Signs posted next to the retail display

Furthermore, MG Chemicals notifies its resellers of their Proposition 65 obligation for those products that are affected.
